



Forest Service Volunteers




- 28,000 volunteers since 1989








Forest Discontinues Steward Program



- Pressure from fires is overwhelming
- Forest decides to temporarily discontinue Steward program
- Forest recognizes contribution of stewards

 Strong reaction from Forest against having Stewards run the program








 Later realization that any program is better for the resource than no program
